
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DESCRIPTION OF PARTS





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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


Step 1

Using a 1/8" Allen/hex key wrench, remove the 4x # 10-24 cover screws so the Front Panel can be removed.



Step 2

Place tablet on the mount, route the cables power, LAN, USB etc. using the large hole on Rear Panel and connect the cables to the tablet.



Step 3

Attach rear panel to mounting surface using 4x screws (not provided in kit) suitable for install location, ensure foam pads are holding securely (the tablet should not be loose) and also ensure the tablet is not contacting the mounting screw heads.



Step 4

Attach power/USB/LAN etc. cables to the tablet securely and route the cable as shown below. PMT recommends using a plastic zip tie where possible to prevent disconnection by using wire clamps provided on Rear Panel.

Step 5

Place the Front Panel over the unit so that the cut-outs align with sensors and camera (side buttons will be covered for tamper resistance) while being careful to not pinch any cables. Carefully re-attach the 4x screws to secure the Front Panel to the Rear Panel.



Installation is now complete.



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
