

DODGE DURANGO (2011+) JEEP GRAND CHERÒKEE (2011+)

The purpose of this instruction sheet is to illustrate the manufacturer's recommended method of installing the Dodge Durango 2011+ vehicle base in a Durango and Grand Cherokee. The base is a simple and discreet solution that installs in minutes and requires no drilling.

Tools Needed

15mm socket Flat head screwdriver 9/16 wrench



Installation

- I. Using the flat head screwdriver or similar tool remove the circular plastic covers over the front seat bolts of the passenger seat.
- 2. Remove the seat bolts located at the front of the passenger seat.
- 3. Slide the seat forward to its limit.
- 4. Using the flat head screwdriver or similar tool open the rectangular plastic covers over the rear seat bolts of the passenger seat.
- 5. Remove the seat bolts located at the rear of the passenger seat.
- 6. Close the rectangular plastic covers.
- 7. Slide the seat backward to its limit.
- 8. Slide the base between the seat legs and the vehicle floor pan (see
- 9. Align the slots of the base with the mounting holes on the seat and vehicle floor.
- 10. Re-insert the bolts removed in STEP 2.
- II. Re-insert the bolts removed in STEP 5.
- 12. Tighten all four (4) seat bolts securing the passenger seat.
- 13. Secure the plastic bolt covers.
- 14. Secure the Offset Riser to the Dodge Durango base.

Floor Bolt Support (Optional)

The stiffness of the base can be increased by securing the front foot with a 1/4-in through bolt. Before adding floor bolts look under the carpet and under the vehicle.


